The San Francisco Italian Athletic Club Foundation (SFIAC) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization created to support the charitable endeavors of the SFIAC, a North Beach cultural and social organization.

At 107 years old, the SFIAC is one of the oldest athletic clubs in the country. The awards program is modeled after the Downtown Athletic Club's Heisman Trophy and recognizes the top high school athletes and coaches in the City of San Francisco. Each of the awards has been named after an Italian American or Club member with ties to San Francisco and has high character that makes him a great role model for our recipients. The event is a fundraiser that supports high school sports in the city.

High School Sports Awards May 13, 2024

The awards banquet honors over thirty-six individual athletes and coaches and one team of the year. Prior team honors have been bestowed on Balboa High School state champion football team and Lincoln High School football. Coaches from Galileo, Lincoln, University, Sacred Heart Cathedral and St. Ignatius high schools have all been honored.

Represented sports include: football, soccer, baseball, softball, volleyball and track and field.

The event is a fundraiser for San Francisco high school sports. The evening includes a dinner banquet and awards presentation. In 2024, we will award scholarships to the top student athletes. Student athletes attend the event as guests of the SFIAC Foundation and their parents are offered reduced rate tickets.

The event is a fundraiser for high school sports in San Francisco with ticket sales and donations to the event going to the SFIAC Foundation (501c3 non-profit) which after paying the event expenses and scholarships contributes the net proceeds to organizations that support high school sports in San Francisco. In past years we typically raised over \$12,000. The primary beneficiary has been the Academic Athletic Association (AAA) which was founded in 1912 and runs the public school leagues in San Francisco. The funds are expected to primarily go to purchase new uniforms and equipment. A portion of the net proceeds will also be donated to Dante's Boys Foundation which supports high school baseball in the memory of Dante Benedetti. Other charities that support San Francisco high school sports may be considered too.
